EXCERPT MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING.

Held in the Apartments of the Geological Society, June 17, 1913, at 5 p.m.

Dr. A. E. H. TUTTON, F.R.S., President, in the Chair.

Prof. Thomas Leonard Walker and Prof. Antonio de Barros Barreto were elected Ordinary Members of the Society.

The death of Dr. K. J. V. Steenstrup, Honorary Member, was announced.

The following changes in the list of Officers and Council were approved for recommendation to the Members of the Society: Messrs. Fleischmann, Hilton, Russell, and Teall, in place of the four retiring Members of Council (Messrs. Barker, Gordon, Pearce, and Thomas).

The President was requested to send on behalf of the Council a letter of congratulation to Professor Groth on his seventieth birthday.

GENERAL MEETING.

Twenty-nine Members and five Visitors were present.

The elections of Prof. T. L. Walker and Prof. A. de Barros Barreto as Ordinary Members of the Society were confirmed.

Mr. W. L. Bragg exhibited and described a series of lantern-slides illustrating crystal-structure as revealed by Röntgen radiation [see Proc. Roy. Soc., 1913, ser. A, vol. 89, p. 248], and other slides illustrating the same subject were exhibited by Dr. Tutton.
