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### ERRATA TO No. 22.

Page 8, line 3, after "points of contact," *read*  
"In the 29th volume of the second series of the *Edinburgh Philosophical Journal*, I have found the following interesting note by Neckar:—"Gallinase of Beal in Skye differs from pitchstone in specific gravity, and by its fusion before the blowpipe into a black scoriaceous enamel. It forms a crust of two or three inches on a basaltic dyke, which traverses the whole valley of Beal, like a prominent wall of basaltic pillars. Probably the vitreous dykes of Caosaigin Mull, and Lamlash are the same." This is evidently tachylite; and it is interesting to have made out what "Gallinase" is, and to have a note of some of its localities. The foregoing contracted analyses of tachylite and pitchstone, however, show differences which external characters could not disclose; and make it markedly evident that tachylite is the slag of a *basic* rock, and pitchstone that of an *acidic* one."
